



Islanders: Many Islands, One Community is an Erasmus+ co-funded project for young people connected to small island communities.

Our goals are to:

- Enable young people to become active and reflective citizens, using storytelling to foster intergenerational connections and understand their past, present and future.
- Celebrate the rich cultural heritages of island communities and reflect on commonalities and differences across Europe.
- Encourage young people to protect and restore the special environments of small islands and imagine sustainable and inclusive futures.
- Foster educational engagement and connection through online workshops, digital creativity, and the power of storytelling.

Islanders is a partnership between youth organisations in Estonia, Greece, Malta, Portugal, and Sweden. For young people (aged 13 to 20) in Sweden we offer:

- **5 webinars** (March to June 2024) based on the project's themes of storytelling, intergenerational connection, cultural heritage, connections with nature, and sustainable futures, each led by a youth organisation from our partnership. Young people will create videos and stories to be shared on our interactive Digital Platform, fostering imagination, digital skills, and transnational connection.
- **5 virtual campfires** (March to June 2024) for young people from all participating countries to meet online and share their experiences and perspectives from their communities.
- A **transnational workshop** (29 July to 2 August 2024) in **Brussels** for 5 young people (aged under 18) and 2 youth workers from each country, bringing the voices of young people from island communities to the centre of Europe. They will deepen their understanding of key issues, share their stories and experiences through the project, learn about European culture and history, and meet visiting experts including representatives of European institutions. All expenses will be covered.
